

RSS BILLY CART DERBY 2022



SPECIFICATIONS & RULES

Races start on a ramp that is designed to suit most carts. It is important that the following sizes be used when building your Billy Cart. **All carts will undergo a safety check and scrutiny before being eligible to race.** Younger drivers can elect to start from the base of the ramps if they wish.



SCRUTINEERING REQUIREMENTS MANDATORY FOR SAFETY IN ALL DIVISIONS

1. Braking must be functional and secure. Brakes must be used to stop after crossing the finish line.
2. No less than 3 wheels.
3. One driver only (excluding Parent & Child).
4. Secured seating.
5. No dangerous protrusions that may cause harm in the event of a collision.
6. Steering wheel/bar with shaft and connected steering rods is permitted for all ages or simple rope to front axle steering must use BOTH feet and hand rope to steer.
7. MAX EFFECTIVE LENGTH: Not to exceed 2000mm from absolute front of cart to centre of rear axle.
8. MAX LENGTH OVERALL: 2200mm overall.
9. MAX WIDTH: 1000mm from outside of wheel to outside of opposite wheel.
10. MAX WHEEL DIAMETER: 700mm.
11. MINIMUM GROUND CLEARANCE:

Recommended 75mm to allow for clearance of the start ramp. Please note that smaller wheels and therefore less ground clearance may not have the clearance for the start ramp and may need to begin at the base of the ramp.

PARENT & CHILD SPECIFICATIONS

- 2 persons (Parent & Child), can be seated either side by side or directly behind.
- BRAKING: It is recommended that the Parent control braking.
